

# 2011-2012 FAFSA on the WEB [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)



- ❖ All students must complete and submit a 2011-2012 Free Application for Federal Student Aid form (FAFSA) to apply for **Federal** student aid (**Pell Grant**). Your FAFSA information may also be used to determine eligibility for state aid (HOPE).
  - This year the Department of Education is encouraging all students to apply online. This is **FASTER** and **EASIER** than using the FAFSA paper application. We have “FAFSA on the WEB Worksheets” at each campus to help you get your information together **BEFORE** you go online and apply on the Web at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov).
  - **BEFORE** beginning FAFSA on the WEB you must apply for a PIN at [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov). You will need a pin to sign your FAFSA with the US Department of Education. You will receive your PIN within a few days, and then you can electronically sign your FAFSA when you submit your information. If you are providing parent information, one parent must sign your FAFSA. To sign electronically, your parent will also need to apply for a PIN at [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov).
  - Go to [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) to complete and submit your 2011-2012 FAFSA application.
- ❖ **If you need assistance completing your FAFSA Application on-line we now have a computer lab in the Student Affairs Office to assist students with the application process.**

- ❖ **Students who do not wish to complete their 2011-2012 FAFSA online have several options:**
  - You can print a 2011-2012 FAFSA application in PDF form, manually complete and mail application. The PDF forms can be found at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). scroll down and click on FAFSA filing options - click on 2011-2012 School Year (July 1, 2011 – June 30, 2012).

  - Students who have limited or no access to the internet can complete the FAFSA on the Phone 1-800-433-3243 Mon-Fri: 8:00 am – 12:00 midnight and Sat: 9:00 am – 6:00 pm

## **Information needed to complete the 2011-2012 FAFSA on the WEB or FAFSA on the Phone:**

1. Your Social Security Number (your parents if you are dependent)
2. Driver’s license number (if you have one)
3. Alien Registration Number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
4. 2010 federal tax returns and 2010 W-2’s for yourself and spouse (if you are married), or your parents (if you are required to provide parent information).
5. Records of untaxed income, such as Social Security benefits, TANF, Veterans Benefits, etc.
6. Information on savings, investments, and business and farm assets for yourself and for your parents if you are dependent
