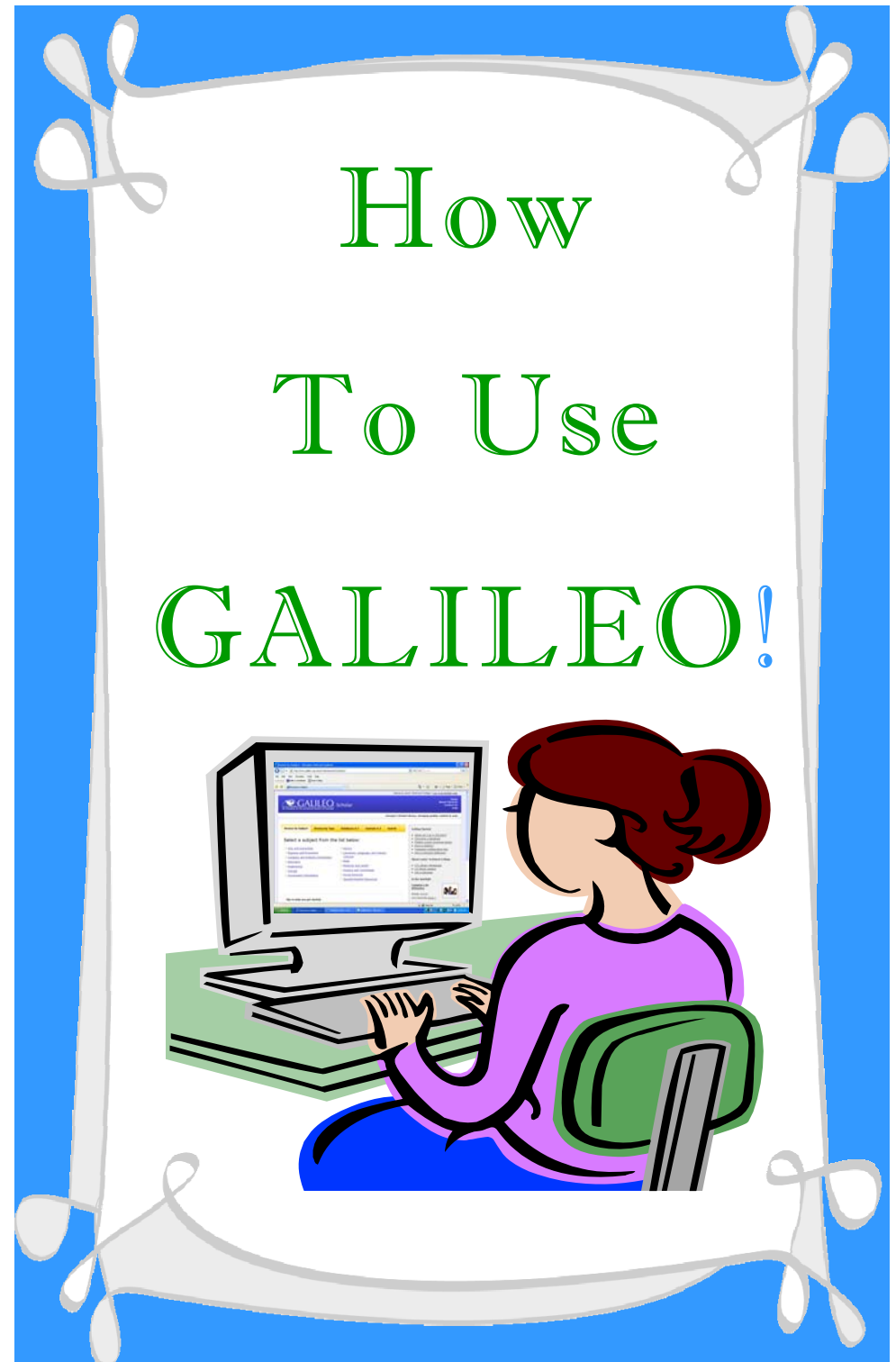

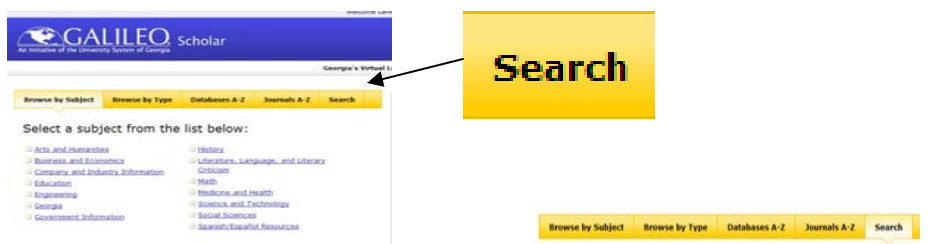


Lots of databases within GALILEO offer full text versions of magazines and professional journal articles.

This guide will take you, step by step, through the process.

1. If you are using the library's Internet computers, click on the GALILEO link. For off-campus use, go to www.laniertech.edu, click on the Library link on the Lanier Tech homepage, and then click on GALILEO from the main Library page. You will need to provide the current password for off-campus use.

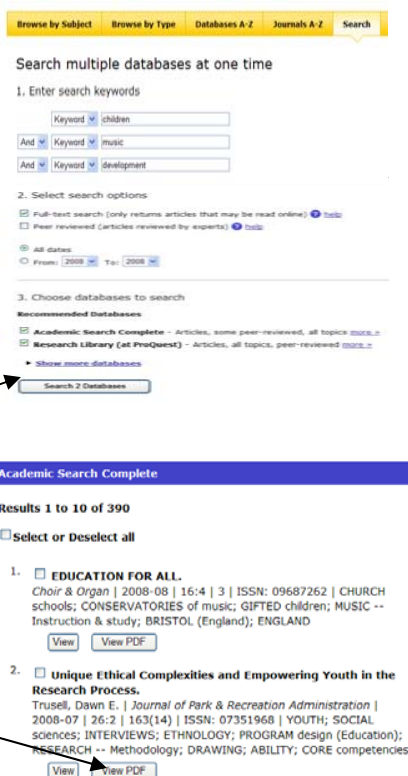
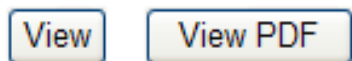
2. On the GALILEO Library screen, click the Search tab (last tab).



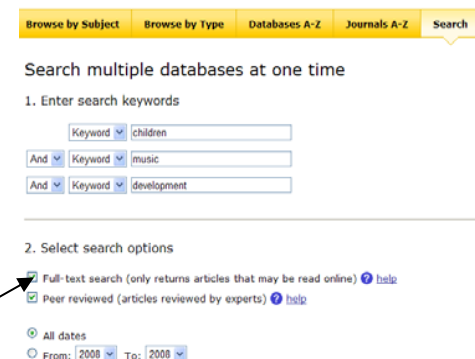
3. For this example we want to find articles about the effect of music on childhood development. In the boxes enter the words "children" and "music" and "development" and scroll down to the bottom to click the **Search 2 Databases** button.

4. View your results. To see a PDF version (as if you were viewing a photocopy of the article) click the **View PDF** button.

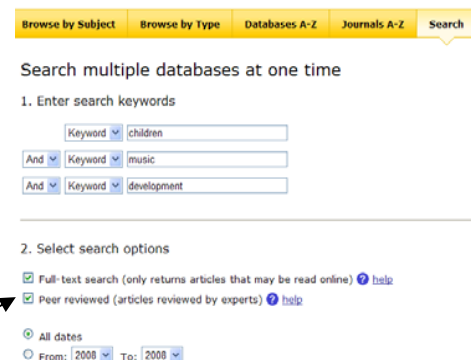


A. If you want only results with the full text of the articles, click on the Full-text search box.



Full-text search (only returns articles that may be read online)

B. If you need peer-reviewed or scholarly journals, click on the peer reviewed check box under the enter search keywords boxes.



Peer reviewed (articles reviewed by experts)

- Not all articles are full text.
- Response time may be slow if the Internet is especially busy.
