1. On the [GALILEO](#) home page (after using the password if you are off-campus) go to the Subject: **Literature, Language & Literary Criticism**, then click on **Literature & Literary Criticism**.
2. Or go directly to [Literature Resource Center \(Gale\)](#) and search from there.
3. Put search words in the boxes, like **Morrison, Toni** or “**The Bluest Eye**”
4. You can try adding another word with those searches, like **beauty**.
5. If you can click on the **Full Text** box, it will only give you hits with the whole article attached, instead of the hits that only have citations.

Using Web sites for research

When using Internet sites as research you **must** evaluate the hits. Only sites put up by experts in the field can be used as research. Good research sites are in the **GALILEO databases**, in **Encyclopedia Britannica** articles, and in the **Library web page** under **Reference Links**.

NetLibrary

E-books in NetLibrary (in **GALILEO**) can be searched by word to find references to your topic. Use the Galileo password if off-campus and search NetLibrary by author or title.
