Dear Student/Prospective Student:

Lanier Technical College uses a selective admission process to enroll students for the [Associate of Science in Nursing](#) program.

One of the various criteria used to determine program acceptance is the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Allied Health entrance test*. It may also be referred to as the ATI TEAS VII (7) Test.

TO REGISTER FOR THE TEAS*, use the following link: <https://www.atitesting.com/teas/register> Once you visit the previous link, you will click "Register Now". You must create a student account, then choose Online Store TEAS from the menu on the left side.

Enter the following information:

Program type: **TEAS for Allied Health** (NOT TEAS for Nursing...this may seem counterintuitive, but Lanier Tech prefers you choose "Allied Health" ... this is related to record-keeping & reports).

Country: USA

State: Georgia

City: Cumming

THE TEAS MUST BE TAKEN IN PERSON. ONLY IN-PERSON TEAS RESULTS ARE ACCEPTED FOR THE ASN PROGRAM. You must present at least one photo ID at the testing location in order to be allowed to test. No transfers or refunds are permitted. Scores from tests taken at approved TEAS testing sites at other institutions must be sent by the testing service to Lanier Technical College.

NOTE: Per the LTC Allied Health division rule, the TEAS Allied Health test may be taken no more than two times in a calendar year with a minimum of 30 days between each attempt. No TEAS test results greater than five (5) years old will be accepted for ASN admission consideration. NO ONLINE OR REMOTE TEAS results will be accepted or considered for admission. The TEAS deadline for each ASN application submission period will be posted on the ASN webpage.

*If a physical handicap or learning disability prevents you from taking the exam under standard conditions, you may request special testing arrangements by contacting teastesting@laniertech.edu at least four weeks before the desired test date.
