Dear Student:

Lanier Technical College uses a selective admission process to enroll students for the Physical Therapist Assistant program. The ATI-TEAS Exam for Allied Health is an admission requirement. Applicants to the PTA Program must take the ATI-TEAS pre-admission test during or after taking the required prerequisite courses. Priority for selection will be given to the students with the highest TEAS percentile scores that have satisfied all prerequisite requirements. Students must score at a minimum of 70% as a composite score. There is a fee required to take the test. The test may be taken more than once, but a fee is charged for each test taken. ATI-TEAS may be taken no more than two times in a calendar year with 30 days between each attempt. No TEAS test accepted greater than 5 years old. ATI-TEAS Exam scores are available to the PTA program at no additional charge to the student if the test is taken at LTC. All TEAS test scores from another institution must be sent to LTC by the testing agency (there is an additional fee to send scores to LTC.). Please note, the PTA Program is only accepting applicants who register and take the TEAS at an "Institution (On Campus)" version. Effective 2/23/2021.

To apply for the ATI-TEAS Exam, contact <u>https://www.atitesting.com/home.aspx</u> (click on Register for TEAS on the right hand side of the page) to pay for the test online and create a user account ten days prior to the test date. You must present a photo ID at the testing session in order to be allowed to test. No Transfers or Refunds allowed. *For more information regarding the ATI-TEAS test email <u>teastesting@laniertech.edu</u>*

*If a physical handicap or learning disability prevents you from taking the exam under standard conditions, you may request special testing arrangements by contacting <u>teastesting@laniertech.edu</u> at least four weeks before the desired test date.
