Dear Dr. Wheelan:

In October 2018, the Commission approved Lanier Technical College to offer five programs in carpentry and construction management:

- NCCER Construction Management Technology Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) 60 credit hours
- NCCER Carpentry Technology Diploma 38 credit hours
- NCCER Carpentry Fundamentals Technical Certificate of Credit (T.C.C.) 17 credit hours
- NCCER Carpentry Technology T.C.C 27 credit hours
- NCCER Advanced Carpentry T.C.C. 18 credit hours

Between October 2018 and now, we have become aware that a newer, revised curriculum for these programs is available. This repackaging of existing curriculum caused the number of credit hours to change for two of the programs:

- NCCER Carpentry Technology Diploma 42 credit hours (originally 38, an 11% difference)
- NCCER Carpentry Technology T.C.C 34 credit hours (originally 27, a 26% difference)

We plan to begin accepting students to these programs this coming fall semester 2019, and we plan to use the most current version of the curriculum.

Ordinarily I would see no reason to involve the Commission in a non-substantive change such as this, but this discrepancy in hours is causing complications with approval of our Recertification for Federal Aid by the Department of Education. The DOE is requiring a letter from the Commission showing approval for these two programs at the required number of hours.

While I understand this not a normal part of the Commission's workflow, I ask that you send a revised letter of approval as soon as possible, showing the revised number of credit hours in each program.
