As part of the review of the submission, additional information was requested by email. The institution's response has been incorporated into the originally-submitted materials.

The institution repackaged its Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree program in Dental Hygiene to an Associate of Science (A.S.) degree program. The State Board of the Technical College System of Georgia approved the termination of the A.A.S. program (December 2020), and your letter of January 26, 2021, provided notification of the program closure.

No students were enrolled in the A.A.S. at the time of your letter of notification. As clarified by email (April 8, 2021), students in the A.A.S. were notified in person of the intended change. Students had the option of remaining in the A.A.S. or switching to the A.S. degree program. Three of the thirteen students who graduated in 2020 remained in the A.A.S. degree in order to maintain their Pell Grant eligibility. The A.S. degree was three semester credit hours shorter than the A.A.S. degree (duplicate course content was removed), and students who chose to remain in the A.A.S. program were able to complete courses without interruption and with no additional cost for program completion.

There was no negative impact on faculty as a result of the program closure. As confirmed by email, there was no change to dental hygiene faculty.



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The Board of Trustees of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges approves the closure of the Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree program in Dental Hygiene.
