Your letter dated December 20, 2021, provided information on the off-campus instructional site (OCIS) closure, effective November 20, 2021. When an institution closes a program or instructional site, it has an affirmative obligation to seek closure approval from SACSCOC at the time the closure decision is made. Interest from high school staff and students at the OCIS has not materialized, and no classes have been offered at the site for over two (2) years. As there are no students enrolled at the site, there are no students to notify of the site closure.

Institutional staff with responsibility for scheduling and delivering courses at the OCIS were informed of the site closure via email from the Vice President of Student Affairs. No Lanier Technical College faculty are teaching at the OCIS, and no faculty are impacted by the closure.
