Please be informed that Lanier Technical College plans to begin offering its Health Information Specialist technical certificate of credit program at Early College @ Jones, an approved off-campus instructional site, beginning August 2017.

The Health Information Specialist TCC – a relatively new program for Lanier Technical College – was approved by the Commission for our Oakwood (main) campus on December 15, 2016. The Hall County School System has expressed great interest in offering this program to its Move on When Ready (dual enrollment) students, as it provides interested students with a pathway into LTC's Health Information Management Technology AAS degree program.
