

ASN End of Program Student Learning Outcomes (EOPSLOs)

The following EOPSLOs are derived from the QSEN Project Prelicensure KSAs. Throughout the ASN Program, and/or upon completion of the ASN Program, the student nurse will:

EOPSLO #1: Recognize the patient or designee as the source of control and full partner in providing compassionate and coordinated care [Patient-centered Care]

EOPSLO #2: Function effectively as a member of the nursing team, and within inter-professional teams, to achieve quality patient care. [Teamwork and Collaboration]

EOPSLO #3: Integrate best current evidence with clinical expertise for delivery of optimal health care. [Evidence-Based Practice]

EOPSLO #4: Use data to monitor the outcomes of care processes, and to continuously improve the quality and safety of health care systems. [Quality Improvement]

EOPSLO #5: Minimize risk of harm to patients and providers through both system effectiveness and individual performance. [Safety]

EOPSLO #6: Use information and technology to communicate, manage knowledge, mitigate error, and support decision-making. [Informatics]

Program Outcomes

1. Licensure Pass Rate NCLEX

Expected Level of Achievement (ELA) for NCLEX-RN® pass-rate: at least 80% pass rate for all first-time test-takers within 12 months of graduation from the ASN Program.

2. Program Completion Rate

70% of all students who begin the first nursing course in the ASN program will complete the program within 4 semesters, which is within 100% of the usual timeframe ASN program.

3. Job Placement Rate

Ninety percent (90%) of graduates will report employment as a RN within 12 months of graduation.
