



### **Articulation Agreement between**

### **Brenau University and Lanier Technical College**

The table below details the Lanier Technical College (LTC) courses that Brenau University (BU) will accept as transfer credit, and how the technical college courses correspond to university courses. This articulation applies to the following Brenau University degree programs:

- Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) Accounting Major
- Bachelor of Arts in Organizational Leadership (BAOL)

Other college courses taken at a degree-granting higher education institution accredited by a regional body, such as but not limited to the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) may also be presented on a case-by-case basis for evaluation as transfer credit to Brenau University. This list is not all-inclusive and should be reviewed and updated periodically by the registrars of LTC and BU to reflect changes in the curriculum at either institution. The agreement will remain in effect until the vice president of academic affairs at either institution gives notice that the agreement should be discontinued at the end of the semester in which such notice is communicated in writing. Should this occur, students currently in the pipeline would still be able to complete their program. This agreement is based on Brenau's 2021 – 2022 BBA and BAOL Program plans.

At the time of this agreement the Brenau University Undergraduate Transfer Credit Policy is as follows:

A grade of "C" or better is required for transfer. Transfer credit is awarded for courses taken at regionally accredited institutions and can not be awarded based on placement tests or non-class credit awarded at other institutions.

- The university will accept ALL liberal education courses regardless of the date of satisfactory completion unless the liberal education course is also a major course.
- 2. The university will accept major courses taken within 15 years unless listed below.
- 3. The university will accept major courses taken within 5 years for the specific courses listed below.
- Exceptions to any policy above will go to the dean of the appropriate school for a final decision.
- 5. Courses with technical content (e.g. computer programming/applications, etc.) taken over five years prior to admission may not be eligible for transfer.
- Changing majors after an admissions decision has been made may alter the eligibility of courses that have been already designated on a previous program
  plan.
- 7. Developmental Studies and English as a Second Language Courses do not transfer.

- 8. In no case will a student be permitted to transfer more than 65 semester hours of credit (97 quarter hours) from two-year institutions to a Brenau program. This 65-hour limit represents the total of all credit taken at all two year colleges the student might have attended before applying for admission to Brenau. This 65-hour maximum does not affect Brenau's minimum residency requirement.
- 9. Departments reserve the right to require a student to take a prerequisite course for a Brenau course at a four-year institution.
- 10. Courses transferred to Brenau are recorded in semester hours. If taken at the previous school in quarter hours, the following calculation is used: quarter hours / 1.5 = semester hours. (ex. 4.5 quarter hours / 1.5 = 3 semester hours.)

All other Brenau University requirements for admission, for acceptance of credit and for graduation must be satisfied.

Residency requirement: A residency requirement of 30 semester hours is required to graduate from Brenau University. This includes a major residency of 21 semester hours, of which 9 semester hours to be in the area of the major concentration. This residency requirement can be fulfilled with either online or on ground course work.
