A Lottery Process Will be Utilized to Select 12 Students Each Fall

Important Information to Consider:

- Entry to this pathway is designed for Sophomores & Juniors
- Students will be required to purchase tools, supplies, and equipment not covered by Dual Enrollment funding
- Students must provide their own transportation to the LTC Campus
- Students must complete a LTC Dual Enrollment Application and apply for one of the Automotive Technology Programs listed above
- Deadline to apply for this program and have all admissions information complete is April 1, 2024, to be considered in the Automotive Technology Pathway Lottery at Barrow Campus





Dual Enrollment - Barrow Automotive Course Lottery (Barrow Campus Only)

Students MUST, to be considered in the course lottery, complete the following items by April 1, 2024

- Student must commit to the course pathway and class times for DE students as presented via the pathway program flyer for Barrow Campus. Any other course variations will not be granted
- Students must complete the LTC application for admissions for Fall Semester 2024, for one of the certificate automotive programs on our website <u>Lanier Technical College - Automotive Technology</u> (<u>smartcatalogiq.com</u>)
- Students must ensure their in-progress high school transcript, placement requirements, residency (if Self/Split/HOPE paying), or any other item required for the application to be complete is submitted, as requested. - Students must complete their GAfutures Dual Enrollment Funding application, and parents/guardians
 must also complete with parent/guardian signature. You may check your status here: <u>GAfutures.org</u> |

- Students must be registered for Selective Service if 18 years of age or within 30 days of their 18th birthday
- Students must be in good standing at the college and not be on academic dismissal or financial aid suspension

Course Pathway Lottery Information

- Twelve (12) seats are available. After twelve seats are pulled, a waitlist will be started beginning with number thirteen (13) through the entire list of applicants
- Acceptance to the program does not guarantee you will be selected for the course pathway, rather, it
 will allow you to be entered into the course pathway lottery
- ONLY students whose application requirements above are met, and are deemed accepted, will be entered into the course pathway lottery
- Lottery drawing will be conducted on April 3, 2024, and we will notify each student of their seat number once the drawing is complete.
