AGREEMENT BETWEEN

& LANIER TECHNICAL COLLEGE

Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia

This is a Joint Institutional Agreement on the part of (on behalf of Georgia Regents University Lanier Technical College (LTC) to formally establish an educational partner ship between the two institutions. This Agreement is made between Lanier Technical College and its associate degree Dental Hygiene program and GRU and its College of Allied Health Sciences baccalaureate degree completion Dental Hygiene program. In this Agreement, GRU and LTC are collectively referred to as the Parties.

The objectives of this Agreement are to facilitate access to a BS degree completion program in dental hygiene and increase the number of dental hygienists who are eligible for advanced careers in education, research, management, and public health. Purpose(s) of the Agreement are to:

- Create a seamless pipeline for AS prepared Dental Hygiene students through a BS degree completion program
- Facilitate the transfer of all viable college courses as required in the University System of Georgia Core Curriculum
- Facilitate the transfer of 30 credit hours of courses of the associate degree program into the BS degree in dental hygiene
- Establish communication network to oversee any collaborative efforts within the departments and offices of academic admissions/advising at each institution

The Agreement provides opportunities for qualified students to achieve the goal of earning both an AS and BS degree in a seamless coordinated curriculum. The parties will work to identify, recruit and select students who clearly demonstrate academic and personal competencies required to function as successful students and future health professionals.

The 60 hours of general education core curriculum and career degree program in dental hygiene are provided at LT C and students receive an Associate of Science degree upon completion. GRU awards 30 hours of professional credit towards the BS-DH degree from hours completed in the dental hygiene career degree program. Students complete an additional 30 hours of the online BS-DH curriculum for a total of 120 hours to receive a B achelors of Science degree in Dental Hygiene.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

 Encourage students to consult with an academic counselor from both institutions as early as possible to plan course work that will best meet their individual educational goals. (GRU)

- 2. Maintain regional accreditation standards (SACS) and professional organization accreditation regulation s.
- 3. Unless otherwise provided by this Agreement, neither party will, without prior written consent of the other party, use in advertising, publicity, or otherwise, the name, trademark, logo, symbol, or other image of the other party or that party's employee or agent.
- LTC students have executed an Authorization for Release of Records and Information.
- 5. An advisory group composed of Institution faculty and administrators will provide oversight for the collaborative program. The Advisory Committee consists of the following members:

- 7. In the event that an Institution's contact person changes, the Institution hereby agrees to promptly notify the other party of such change.
- 8. This agreement shall not be interpreted to guarantee admission of LTC students into GRU. LTC students must apply for admission to GRU consistent with other applicants. Requirements for admission into the BS degree completion program at GRU include:

- A. Completion of the Associate degree in dental hygiene.
- B. Completion of the core curriculum for a Bachelor of Science degree as stipulated by the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia.
- C. An overall GPA of 2.5 of all course work as determined by the Office of Admissions at Georgia Regents University.
- D. Recommendation by the Dental Hygiene faculty at Lanier Technical College.
- This agreement is valid starting with the date of execution of both parties and remains in effect until terminated in writing by either institution. If the program is terminated, students already admitted to the program will be allowed to complete the program.
