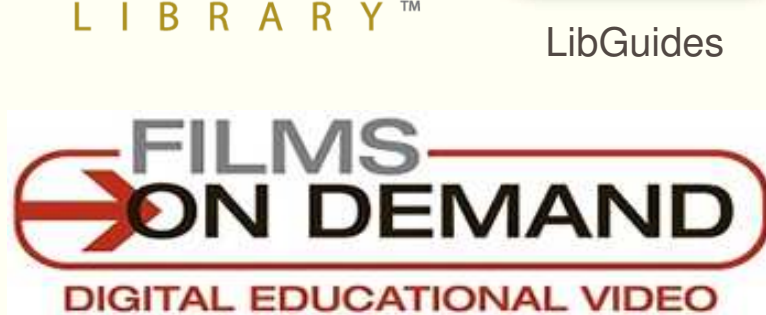

# Library Catalog

Primo is the new library online library catalog.

- Search for print and electronic books and search the Films on Demand database
- If what you need is not available in your local campus library or in the LTC system, you can request books through TechShare
- Ask your friendly campus librarian about how to get the most out of Primo



## TechShare ***TechShare***

---

- What is TechShare? TechShare is a service where you can request library books from other colleges in the Technical College System of Georgia (TCSG).
- Who can use TechShare? Students, Staff, and Faculty at all TCSG colleges
- What can I borrow? Circulating books only. AV materials and reference books are not available through TechShare.
- TechShare lets you utilize library collections from 22 TCSG colleges across Georgia.
- TechShare gives you access to books that might be unavailable to you at your college. Remember to use the Request options in Primo (library catalog) to find the information you need.
- Ask your friendly campus librarian for more information.



GALILEO stands for Georgia Library Learning Online, an initiative of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia. GALILEO is an online library portal to authoritative, subscription-only information that isn't available through free search engines or Web directories. Participating institutions may access over 100 databases indexing thousands of periodicals and scholarly journals. Over 10,000 journal titles are provided in full-text. Other resources include encyclopedias, business directories, and government publications.

- Use the LTC LibGuides to help narrow down your search topic
- Go to the library's website for the GALILEO link. You will need to log into OpenAthens with your full student email address and password if you are off-campus

- Most are accessible through Primo (library catalog)
- Searchable by title, keyword, author, or subject

## Britannica Academic Britannica<sup>®</sup> ACADEMIC

---

The **Encyclopædia Britannica** database includes thousands of articles from the printed Encyclopædia Britannica, including thousands more that are not found in the print set. The resource also includes year-in-review articles from recent yearbooks, The Britannica Student Encyclopedia, and Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary and Thesaurus. Most articles are brief or of moderate length and discuss people, places, institutions, things, or concepts. Longer articles are divided into separate sections for easier access and more accurate searching.

- The database also includes an extensive World Atlas linking users to maps, flags, statistics, and more for many countries. The Web Sites section in each article includes links to related Web sites, selected for content by Britannica editors.
