TEAS Score

The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) for Allied Health measures basic academic preparedness in the content area domains of reading, mathematics, science, English and language usage. To be valid for the PTA program, *the ATI-TEAS for Allied Health exam may be taken no more than 2 times in a calendar year with 30 days between each test attempt. No TEAS test accepted greater than 5 years old. Only "on-campus" TEAS Test Scores are accepted.*

Your ATI-TEAS for Allied Health exam must be taken at Lanier Technical College or you must have your scores sent to Lanier Technical College. There is a fee to have your scores sent to Lanier Technical College. In addition, please include the paper copy of your test results with your application. The program will no longer accept only the paper copy with your application.

The minimum score on the ATI TEAS Test to be considered a qualified applicant is 70.0%

Instructions for Prerequisite G.P.A. Forms---EXAMPLE

Each G.P.A. form MUST BE COMPLETED & included with your application packet.

- An example of how to calculate a G.P.A. has been provided below. Utilize the **Prerequisite G.P.A. Form** at the bottom of this page calculate your grade point averages and record the averages on Page 1 of the application.
- If you are enrolled in a course or intend to enroll in a prerequisite course and do not have a grade at the time the form is completed, do not include the number of credit hours or quality points in the respective (QH) or (QP) columns; simply place an X in the boxes (QH) and (QP) next to the required course identified. Please indicate the course is to be taken or currently in progress in the column where the grade would be recorded. Simply write "in progress" or indicate when you plan to take the course.

1. Once all information has been placed in the appropriate column, total the QH column (number of credit hours **QH**) for the courses that have been completed. If a grade has not been earned, simply place an **X** in the **QH** column for that course.
2. The equivalent value must be assigned for the grade earned for the course. If you earn an A, then it is equivalent to a 4, and so on. (A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1, F=0) If a grade has not been earned, simply place an **X** in the **QP** column for that course.
3. Calculate the **QP** for each course by multiplying number of credit hours (QH) by the equivalent value of the grade earned for the class.
4. Total the last column, quality points/**QP**, and then complete the formula **Total QP ÷ Total QH = G.P.A**
5. Complete the **Prerequisite G.P.A. Form** below and record averages on Page 1 of the application.
