

An Agreement to Continue a Transfer Articulation Agreement Between Piedmont University and  
Lanier Technical College  
**Academic Years 2023-2028**

This agreement continues a plan whereby an undergraduate student that completes the Early Childhood Care and Education Associate of Applied Science Degree program at Lanier Technical College may transfer to Piedmont University to complete a bachelor's degree in Elementary Education.

**Acceptance of Transfer Credits at Piedmont University**

The following guidelines will be used to award transfer credit:

- Students who have been out of high school for at least 3 years and transfer in at least 30 credit hours will be marked as Degree Completion Students. A full explanation of this policy can be viewed in the undergraduate catalog at this link (<https://tinyurl.com/2b7uzps2>)
- Successful completion of an AA (Associate of Arts) or an AS (Associate of Science) satisfies all general education requirements.
- The transfer of credits is consistent with and subject to the conditions prescribed in each institution's published catalog at the time of the student's transfer request.
- Credit is transferrable only for courses in which a grade of C or above is earned.
- Transferred courses must be comparable to college-level courses judged to be equivalent in content and quality to Piedmont University courses.
- Completion of the Early Childhood Care and Education program at the technical college level does not guarantee admission to Piedmont University. Candidates must successfully meet all requirements for admission to Piedmont University and the desired degree program.
- Transfer students must also apply to Admission to Teacher Education (ATE) during their first semester of enrollment at Piedmont University. This includes passing a background check, taking and passing the GACE Ethics Exam (360), becoming a student member of PAGE (Professional Association of Georgia Educators), a writing evaluation, and other steps.
- Transfer students will also have to take and pass the GACE content exams before entering their final internship. Students cannot progress into the final semester of the program without passing scores on the GACE content.
- Transfer students are responsible for consulting the Piedmont University Catalog and for knowing their program requirements.

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- All students, regardless of transfer status, must earn at least 120 hours to be considered for graduation.
- A minimum of 25% of the program coursework or 30 credit hours must be completed at Piedmont University.
