1. ATI TEAS v. 7 This category is required.	Limited to 2 attempts per calendar year with a minimum of 30 days between attempts. Minimum composite score of 60%. Greater than 75% is automatically accepted into the program. ***Scores valid between June 1 and May 31 preceding the Fall application year. (Ex. June 1, 2024 to May 31, 2025 for Fall 2025 start) ***Must be proctored in-person at a Lanier Tech campus. TEAS Score= # of points awarded	_____/100
2. Active Licensure/ Certification. *5 points awarded for ONLY ONE.	This category is not required.
