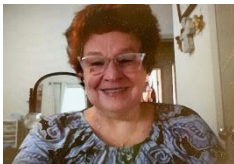
"My English tutor really helped me figure out the sociology paper writing style and went through with me on API style writing." Shraddha D.

One goal of Lanier Tech’s Quality Enhancement Plan is to provide a “robust tutoring program” which enhances student learning of subject material and of learning techniques. To this end, Lanier Tech offers tutoring in biology, chemistry, math, physics, and writing as part of Lanier Tech’s Student Success Center. All Lanier Tech tutors meet certain qualifications in their subject areas and attend regular tutor training to qualify as a Lanier Tech tutor. This semester, tutoring is offered online through BlackBoard Collaborate.

So, who are these tutors? Let’s get to know some of the writing tutors.
