TRANSFER CREDIT AGREEMENT Between REINHARDT UNIVERSITY And LANIER TECHNICAL COLLEGE

This agreement establishes the guidelines under which students who earn credit from Lanier Technical College may transfer to Reinhardt University. Both institutions agree to:

- 1. Maintain a Reinhardt University/Lanier Technical College Coordination Committee comprised of representatives from both institutions that will; (a) hold regular meetings to determine and implement a regular review cycle for the purpose of examining proposed syllabi for transferable courses, and (b)monitoring cooperative administrative processes for admission, financial aid, and academic records.
- 2. Acknowledge that the Vice President and Dean for Academic Affairs at Reinhardt University is to maintain a collaborative working relationship with the VP of Academic Affairs at Lanier Technical College and be administratively responsible for the oversight and coordination of this transfer program.
- 3. Award transfer credit from Lanier Technical College to Reinhardt University for the following courses:

- 5. Students transferring to Reinhardt University from Lanier Technical College must satisfy the admission requirements of Reinhardt University. Reinhardt University will evaluate each applicant and accept or reject the applicant based on established admission policies.
- 6. Any additional courses considered for transfer from Lanier Technical College to Reinhardt University must be reviewed for collegiate content by the Coordination Committee under the administrative supervision of the Vice President and Dean for Academic Affairs at Reinhardt University.

This agreement is entered into for Fall Semester 2012. This agreement may be amended at any time by mutual written consent of both parties. This agreement may also be cancelled at any time by either party with at least ninety (90) days written notice to the other party. If this agreement is cancelled, Lanier Technical College and Reinhardt University will work together to ensure that students currently applying at Reinhardt University will have an opportunity to transfer their courses.
