



Dear Student:

Lanier Technical College uses a selection admission process to enroll students for the Practical Nursing Program.

The following criteria must be met for selection to the Practical Nursing Program:

1. Students need a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 of all college courses.
2. There are 5 pre-requisite classes. All pre-requisite courses must be completed by the end of Spring Semester and prior to the application deadline. The required pre-requisite courses include:
 - a. A minimum grade of "C" must be achieved in all 5 required pre-requisite courses to apply to the program.
 - i English: Fundamental English (ENGL 1010) OR Composition and Rhetoric (ENGL 1101)
 - ii Math: Foundations of Math (MATH 1012) OR College Algebra (MATH 1111) OR Equivalent*
 - iii Science: Structure and Function of the Human Body (ALHS 1011 OR Anatomy and Physiology I and II with labs (BIOL 2113, BIOL 2113L, BIOL 2114, and BIOL 2114L)
 - iv Psychology: PSYC 1010 OR PSYC 1101
 - v Medical Terminology: ALHS 1090
 - b. Grade verification will be made with the Registrar with all contingent applicants.
*Equivalent math courses include the following: Math 1113 (Pre- Calculus), Math 1131 (Calculus I)
*The following math courses will not be accepted: Math 1127 (Intro to Statistics), Math 1103 (Quantitative Skills and Reasoning), Math 1101 (Mathematical Modeling).
3. Students must complete American Heart Association CPR Certification (**BLS for Healthcare Providers**) and **Heartsaver First Aid certification**. Both certification cards must be current by the scheduled PN orientation date which will be given once the student is accepted into the PN program.
4. Students applying for the PN program will be initially admitted into the Healthcare Assistant Certificate program in order to complete the required support and/or core courses for their program of study.
5. Students must submit completed LTC PN Application for selection by noon on the first Friday in June for fall semester consideration.
6. Students must take the ATI TEAS version 7, "Allied Health" pre-admission test prior to applying to the PN Program. The test must be taken in person, but may be taken at any

location offered by ATI. A minimum 60% composite score is required. There is a fee required to take the test. The test may be taken more than once, but the fee will be charged for each test taken. The test may be taken twice in a calendar year with 30 days between test attempts. TEAS Scores are good for 5 years only.

7. Practical Nursing admission is a competitive selection process. Selection criteria consists of cumulative GPA, GPA in prerequisite courses, accumulated points on the Admission Points worksheet, and ATI TEAS score. Meeting the minimum program requirements does not guarantee an applicant's acceptance into the program. The PN program admits a cohort every fall on the Hall campus. Only students that have completed all prerequisites will be considered for selection.

Transfer students must submit a transfer of credit evaluation form to the Registrar's Office and have all transfer of credit evaluations finalized prior to applying to the PN Program.

To apply for the ATI TEAS test, go to www.atitesting.com (go to Individuals, Students, PreProgram, TEAS Entrance Exam Prep) to pay for the test online and create a user account ten days prior to the test date. You must present a photo ID at the testing session in order to be allowed to test. No transfers or refunds allowed.

*If a physical handicap or learning disability prevents you from taking the exam under standard conditions, you may request special testing arrangements by contacting disability services or 770.533.7003 at least four weeks before the desired test date.

To prepare for the exam students should purchase the ATI TEAS Seventh Edition study manual.

Lanier Technical College Practical Nursing Program accepts the Allied Health TEAS exam. The exam may be taken in a proctored in-person environment at any location offered. A downloaded copy of your TEAS score report must accompany your [application](#).
