Brush Up on Your Algebra Skills with Workshop Wednesdays

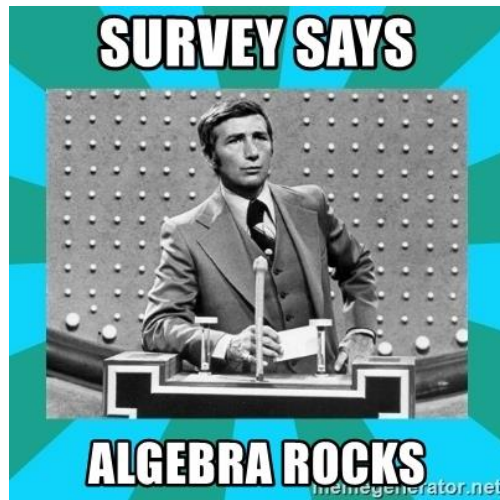
